FC Ryukyu's home games are held at the Okinawa Prefecture Athletic Stadium in Okinawa City. It takes about 50-60 minutes from Naha Airport by car. It takes about 1 hour and 10 minutes by bus. We recommend arriving early as the parking lot in the park can get crowded.

GAME DAY

**150 minutes
before kick-off**

Arrive at the stadium! Experience the atmosphere with the stage, food trucks, and merchandise booths.



**120 minutes
before kick-off**

Welcome the players as they enter the stadium. Feel the excitement building as you soak up the atmosphere of supporters and fans cheering for you!



**90 minutes
before kick-off**

Outside the stadium, there will be a plethora of special events, including dance performances, talk shows, and player autograph sessions!

**60 minutes
before kick-off**

before kick-off**

SEAT

Main Stand unreserved seats



The main stand is close to the event area with food and drink booths and the merchandise store. We recommend it for your first game.

Back unreserved seats



The center of the back stand offers a good view of the game. The areas closer to the sides are where supporters passionately cheer, so if you want to get in on the action right alongside the players, we recommend the back unreserved seats.
